



Windham Schools Addition & Renovation

This project consisted of additions and renovations to the Windham Middle School, (pictured) and the Windham Center Elementary School,

which are located two miles apart. The total square footage of new construction exceeded 60,000 square feet. The Center School addition consisted of 37,000 square feet, with space added at three different locations onto the original school.

Both schools were in session during the construction period, and work at both schools was completed in time for re-opening day in September 2000 as scheduled. Since the project was going so well, in March 2000 the Town of Windham voted to appropriate an additional 1.3 million dollars and expand the work to Brookstone Builders. Total dollar value of the completed project approached 6.4 million dollars.
